The purpose of this 2-day live-fire law enforcement program is to increase a patrolman's survivability against heavily armed offenders in and around a motor vehicle. The primary focus is to identify practical emergency vehicle deployment techniques and the complexities associated with a vehicle's confined space involving:

Emergency Evacuation - Counter-Ambush - Citizen/ Officer Rescue

The majority of a patrol officer's career is spent in a vehicle. While at the same time traditional live-fire training programs consist of practicing in an environment absent a vehicle. This training program bridges the gap by introducing required live-fire weapons handling skills for patrol vehicle operations.

Each officer is required to bring the following equipment:

Body armor	AR-15 rifle with SLING	Pistol w/holster
Ballistic helmet w/chin strap	Chamber Blocking Device (CBD)	3 pistol mags
Hearing protection	3 rifle magazines	500 rds. of pistol ammo
Eye protection	500 rds. of rifle ammo	Water
Long sleeve shirt and pants	Soft finger gloves	Gatorade
Note book and pen	Knee and elbow pads optional	Lunch each day
