Tactical Emergency Casualty Care

Dates: May 4-5, 2017 **Times:** 8:00 am – 4:00 pm **Location:** Gurnee IL.

This 16 hour, realistic street level emergency care course will provide Police Officers and Paramedic / EMS personnel the opportunity to practice emergency casualty care in simulated active threat / crisis situations. Police and Fire / EMS will work cohesively to identify, treat and transport patients from the warm and hot zones under simulated threat conditions. The skills sets learned and practiced in this course will save lives on the street! This knowledge will help you identify the most critically injured persons, provide them with advanced emergency care and give them the best chance they will have to survive. This is a hands-on class, you will do emergency medical care skill sets until you are confident you can do them blindfolded. The goal will be to challenge you so when the real event happens you are prepared. Course Graduates will receive a TCCC certificate.

PREREQUISITES: This course is open to all sworn LE and EMS regardless of current medical skill level.

Course Content

- **Direct Threat Care** – Care that is rendered while under or in adverse condition
- **Indirect Threat Care** – Care that rendered while the threat has been suppressed, but may resurface at any point
- **Evacuation** – Care that is rendered while the casualty is being evacuated from the incident site
- Tourniquet placement / Wound packing / Surgical Airway / Chest seals / Chest decompression
- Patient assessment/movement/collection / Pre-post written exam
- FINAL SCENARIO

Equipment:

- All medical training material and equipment will be provided.

- Wear clothes you can get simulated blood on dirty or torn
- The way you go on duty is encouraged for day two.

The learning will be broken up with lecture and hand on skills.
