Live Fire Active Threat Urban Tactics CQB

November 6-10, 2017

Mid-South Institute (Lake Comorant, Mississippi)

This five-day live fire urban tactics / CQB course has been designed to provide officers with the opportunity to practice and perform live fire tactical maneuver skill sets that will enhance their ability to respond to active threat situations.

Prerequisite: Officers attending should be proficient in Rapid Deployment / Active Threat / MACTAC Urban Techniques & Tactics. Firearms proficiency and capabilities are also required. ***This is not a beginner's course – please do not send officers who are not proficient in these high-risk patrol skill sets.***

Course curriculum will include:

Safety protocols; verbal skills and utilizing common terms; individual movement tactical skills; buddy team movement tactics; contact team movement tactics; firearms handling protocols; pistol & rifle skill sets; integrated movement & communication tactics for first responders; team formations; link up procedures; bounding overwatch: interior & exterior movement; room entries; building clearing operations; threat neutralization drills; urban tactical operations and movement techniques; use-of-force decision making; integration during multi-agency response.

Each training participant is required to bring the following equipment:
