## **High Risk Patrol Tactics**

**Date:** September 13-14-15, 2017

**Time:** 2:00 pm - 10:00 pm

**Location:** NIPSTA - Glenview

**COURSE DESCRIPTION:** This three-day, 24-hour course has been designed to provide Police Officers with the knowledge and skill sets required when responding to and performing high risk patrol operations. The focus of this program will be on high risk vehicle stops; building & area searches; arrest situations; indoor and outdoor active threat response and downed officer / injured citizen rescues.

The course will include multiple Realistic Scenario Based Training Modules. These scenarios will include live role players and realistic training props to enhance the realism of the training events and allow officers the opportunity to practice in the most realistic conditions possible.

The course requires every attendee to be equipped with a converted patrol rifle and pistol that shoot marking cartridges. A limited supply of converted pistols and AR15 drop in bolts will be available for those that do not have their own converted weapons. Officers are required to have converted weapons and supply their own marking ammunition. Officers must have a minimum of 150 marking rounds (any color). Officers should also bring protective mask and neck protection if available. ITOA can supply protective gear. Acceptable marking rounds include: 9mm Simunition / 9mm & .223 UTM & Force-on-Force Brands. Airsoft is also acceptable. **Paint Ball and 1<sup>st</sup> Generation Simunition brand .223 marking rounds may NOT be utilized in this course.**

**COURSE PREREQUISITES:** Sworn Police Officer
