COURSE DESCRIPTION: This three day, 24-hour course has been designed to train first responding officers in Rapid Deployment/Immediate Action tactics. The focus of this program will be to provide officers with the knowledge and specialized tactical skills they will need to respond during an active shooter type situation. Rapid Deployment/Immediate Action is the swift and immediate deployment of law enforcement resources to an ongoing, life threatening “Active Threat” type situations.

Topics to be addressed include:

Deployment and firearms handling skills / Immediate entry and movement tactics
Solo Officer response tactics & techniques / 2-3-4-5 Officer team tactics
Building & room clearing tactics / Arrest Team tactics
Emergency medical intervention and rescue team techniques / Use of force and safety priorities
Equipment and identification requirements / Participation in realistic scenario based training

COURSE PREREQUISITES: This course is open to all sworn police officers.
