### Bonus training prior to the FTX:

The Rifle Diagnostics class is optional and not required to shoot the Rifle-Pistol FTX. For those attending the Diagnostics class, it will begin at 1600 hrs. in the big classroom at District 5 range and end at 1730 hrs. It will cover issues of slings, sights, optics, and shooting positions. You can come at any time if unable to be there at the beginning.

The FTX will test the participants' skills as they relate to cold weather low light/no light environments. Law enforcement officers of any specialty are encouraged to attend.

***\*Pre-registration is mandatory and no walk-ins will be permitted.***

### Each participant is required to bring the following equipment:

- Body armor (can be soft or hard armor)
- Clear eye protection (corrective lenses must be covered by impact resistant type shooting glasses)
- Hearing protection
- Semi-auto patrol type rifle/carbine w/sling - 3 magazines minimum
- Semi-auto duty pistol – three magazines minimum
- Weapon mounted lights for both handgun and patrol rifle are highly recommended.
- Rifle mounted lights will be needed for the courses of fire.
- Handheld flashlight(s) are required to be used with duty handgun where none is attached and for use on the range for non-shooting needs.
- Holster
- Rifle magazine pouches
- Pistol magazine pouches
- Cold weather gear - Lunch and warm beverage
- Minimum - 200 rounds semi-auto rifle ammunition
- Minimum - 100 rounds pistol ammunition

**NOTE: Safety rules will be strictly enforced and any unsafe equipment will be ordered off the line at the discretion of ITOA.**
